#### Sense of Smell

The nose lets us identify pleasant or unpleasant odors. Some smells can make us sick, others can help us remember good memories!




#### Sense of Sight

We use our eyes to look around and see the environment. We see the light through our eyes.




Our five senses are our connection to the world. We use them to communicate and interact with everything around us!



#### Sense of Toste

Our taste buds allow us to taste four main flavors: salty, sweet, sour, and bitter. Our tongues also tell us if food is cold, hold, spicy, or crunchy!



#### Sense of Touch


Our sense of touch allows us to tell if things are smooth or rough, cold or hot, soft or hard, and dull or sharp.



#### Sense of Hearing

We use our ears to detect sound from the environment. Hearing lets us engage, listen, and laugh!





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
